MPET donates 6,400 euros to Kinderkankerfonds & Me To You

On Monday 29 January, terminal operator MPET (MSC PSA European Terminal) handed over a cheque for 3,200 euros to ngo Kinderkankerfonds in Ghent. At the end of last year, 3,200 euros was handed over to the Me To You foundation. "I am of course proud that we can support the Children's Cancer Fund and Me To You, good causes that are close to everyone's heart," says CEO of MPET Johan Van Daele. "The choice to support them is based on a deep appreciation for the crucial role the organisations play in the lives of children and adults sadly affected by that terrible disease."

Old scrap iron is collected annually at the MPET terminal, with the proceeds traditionally donated to various charities. "Over the years, we have built lasting relationships with various charities," Van Daele stresses. "We are more than a terminal operator, we are also a company that attaches great importance to our social role."

MSC PSA European Terminal (MPET) is a joint venture between PSA and Terminal Investment Limited (TIL). With an annual throughput capacity of 9 million TEU, a quay length of 3.7 km and a surface area of 242 ha, MPET is the largest container terminal in Europe and accounts for more than 50% of Antwerp's total container volume. MPET is equipped with 38 container cranes and has 11 berths to handle the largest ships in the world.
